

- Policy recommendations
  - At the sectoral level
  - Cross-cutting (e.g. carbon price, land planning, research...)
- Implementation
  - Carbon budgets up to 2028
  - Indicators




# Presentation of SNBC-1

- Elaboration process
  - National Energy Transition Dialogue (DNTE, 2012-2013)
  - Stakeholders involvement
    - Information and orientation committee (ministries, businesses, NGOs, trade unions, territories, academics...)
    - Sectoral meetings
  - Public consultation
    - Web platform



# Towards SNBC-2

- Revision clause every 5 years from 2019 on (2015 energy transition law)
- First progress report with indicators published in January 2018
- New Climate Plan (July 2017)
- Expected features
  - Carbon neutrality by 2050
  - Update the projections and extend them to 2050
- Process
  - Similar to SNBC-1
  - Joint with the revision of the 5-year energy plan
  - Articulated with the new adaptation plan
  - Enhanced participation from the public
  -

# Recommendations

- Still an ongoing process... But already a few lessons learnt
- Modeling work is crucial to bridge the « reality gap »
  - Ex. transport sector, buildings...
- Monitoring, taking additional measures where needed
- Impact assessment, in terms of :
  - Growth
  - Jobs
  - Inequalities
- Stakeholders involvement
  - Inter-ministerial plan
  - Stakeholders provide useful inputs for the modeling work
  - Ensures the full buy-in of the strategy




Figure 5.1: Evolution of the GDP gap and contribution of GDP aggregates (NEMESIS model)
