Vehicle manufacturing – at risk due to value chain restructuring as a result of the electrification of transport

Basic materials industry – new technologies and business models required to address process emissions

Place-based just transition – **beyond the industrial regions**

Mid-size cities and towns dependent on emission-intensive industrial plants

Suburbs and small towns dependent on car commutes

Rural regions – transition in agriculture

Socio-economic transition – **beyond decarbonisation**

Demographic challenge – aging and declining population

Technological change strengthening polarisation and limiting diffusion forces
